Tri State and Sculptors Inc. Exhibition

Artists Reception Oct. 8, 7:00 to 9:00 pm

Members will have the opportunity to exhibit two works, one work in the Primary Exhibition plus one miniature work in the Micro Monumental Miniature exhibit.

- I) **Primary Exhibition:** a free standing or wall work to be exhibited in **one** of three venues:
- 1) Center For the Arts Gallery and Holtzman Gallery
 - 2) Center for the Arts Public Space (for larger non fragile works)
 - 3) Outdoor space surrounding the Center for the Arts (for works capable of outdoor Exhibition and with the approval of the Univ. Committee for Campus Installations)

We encourage members to **send jpegs of two works** for our Gallery Committee to select from. It will be a challenge to exhibit at least one work from each member given the combined nature of the exhibit, Tri State and Sculptors Inc.. Therefore, we are encouraging sculptors to submit wall works or at least the option for us to consider both **wall works or free standing works.**

II) **Micro Monumental Exhibition:**

For this exhibition the work must fit into a box that is 14cm x 8cm x 5cm. (not inches) (the work can be smaller than those dimensions , but not larger)
It cannot expand beyond those dimensions once it is removed from the box.
